Day 1/ KAKADU (Wed. 20th) FREE DAY

Bitter Springs is the most beautiful natural thermal pool surrounded by lush greenery, with crystal clear blue water. **(B)**

Day 6/ KATHERINE (Mon. 25th)

Nitniluk Gorge, which consists of 13 ancient sandstone gorges, is simply superb with its rock formations and reflections! As the sun sets, Katherine Hot Springs is the perfect spot to end our stay in Katherine. **(B,D)**

Day 7 / DARWIN (Tues. 26th)

Beautiful tropical Darwin with its multicultural vibe, is surrounded by quirky cafes, restaurants, buzzing night markets and superb galleries. On the way, we will visit **Litchfiled National Park**, with its cascading waterfalls and swimming holes, surrounded by spectacular rock formations. **(B)**

Day 8/ DARWIN (Wed. 27th)

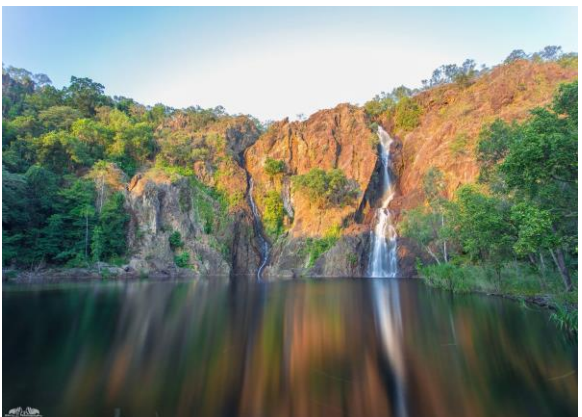
